Description: Each year the Green Mountain Council in Vermont offers a variety of opportunities for Scouts to ski in Vermont. We will be taking the opportunity to visit Bromley Mountain. Each year more than a thousand scouts attend this event. We will be assigned a location for sleeping i.e., a gymnasium or church. Breakfast is provided both days and Saturday dinner. The Scouts will be responsible for bringing dinner on Friday night and lunch each day. There is also a Scout ski race on Saturday at 1pm. Last year we stayed at the Manchester Elementary School.

When: Departure will be Friday February 5 – there is no set time to leave – dinner is on your own Friday night

Return will be on Sunday, February 7th (It is superbowl Sunday again so last year most people left by 2pm.)

Cost: There are a variety of options available with regards to lift tickets, lessons and rentals. Handouts will be available or you can go on the web site: www.scoutingvermont.org and check out ski madness.

Payment in full is due by January 1, 2010. The entire payment is NON-REFUNDABLE because the Vermont Council must purchase tickets, food, sleeping space and options ahead of time. **Checks should be made payable to Troop 474.**
